1932/33

Referring to the May 1992 (number 90) Diary when a 1929 photograph of the pupils was published, and I understand generated much interest, I have recently come into possession of another which I date 1932/33. It shows Mr E.T. Griffiths, the headmaster who succeeded the one dismissed for an educational indiscretion.

Again students are from Penlyne, Trecoed, Llangan, and St. Mary Hill, most of whom I can name, and some, and possibly their descendants, are still in the Diary distribution area.

To the lady from Pencoed whom I understand made an enquiry regarding the 1929 photograph, Mervyn is second from the left in the rear row. I hope it answers her query and others will have an interest in the photograph generally.
